Sheila Noon has been painting portraits for over 20 years, doing commissions overseas, exhibiting and selling well in local galleries. She has also won several awards.

Sheila says that “Most people say that you can only draw, not paint with pastels” Sheila challenges this statement and says that “with pastels you are using paint pigment - just in a different way.” She says that she “breaks her pastels into one inch segments which gives her a chance to paint light and shade by covering area not just creating a series of lines.”

Workshop Outline:

The workshop is for beginners and experienced artists who are interested in painting portraits with pastels.

Sheila will demonstrate and discuss how she paints a face and how she uses pastel to do so. Participants can paint from a photograph of a friend or family member and will receive one on one assistance, where necessary. Everyone should have a finished or near finished portrait at the end of the workshop. (What a great idea for Xmas!)

Materials to Bring:

Photographs of people you wish to paint
Charcoal for drawing
Soft pastels of all colours
Pastel paper, pale and or dark colours
Easel etc.
