The cost of these classes is \$168 for 8 (eight) weeks x 3 hours per class.

Participants will be guided through the process of observing and drawing plants accurately. Basic drawing techniques will be covered using plants as the subject matter. Plants will be examined carefully and fundamental botanical terminology will be explained. By the end of the course, participants should feel comfortable drawing botanical subjects and have developed close observational skills.



Participants are not expected to have any prior drawing or botanical experience.

Materials list for participants

Sketch book, visual diary or sketch pad

Pencils (2H)

Kneadable (putty) eraser

Small transparent plastic ruler with clearly marked measurements

Large clipboard or drawing board

Stanley/craft knife, razor blade or scalpel

Fine forceps or tweezers for holding and dissecting flowers

Reading glasses if you need to use them!

Optional: Magnifying glass (or jewellers loop or hand lens), magnification x10 or more

Optional: A small cutting board for dissecting specimens

Optional: Dissecting kit with forceps, scalpel, dissecting needles

Optional: A pair of dividers (geometry set)
