ACRYLIC PAINT POURING TECHNIQUES with GLORIA ELPHINSTONE

The cost of these classes is \$72 for 4 (four) weeks x 3 hours per class. Plus additional fee per week 1-3, \$7.50. Week 4 - \$10 (paid to Tutor before each class)

You do not have to be an artist to do this technique. It is enjoyable for all, from beginners to accomplished artists.

Acrylic paint pouring is very addictive, therapeutic and fun to do. I say it's like a box of chocolates, you do not know what you are going to get until you pour the paint on your canvas. Choose your colours that go together or your favourites; it might be best to have one of the paint colours a darker tone. I guess the 'rule' in painting is shading, dark and light, contrast and complementary. I would apply that to paint pouring as well. But you can have any colours that you like.

There is a step by step instruction demonstration followed by you applying it and producing your own creation. No two paintings will be identical.

Program Techniques

Week 1 – Introduction & Dirty cup plus ring pour

Week 2 – Spatula Swipe and string pull

Week 3 - Acrylic Dip - canvas and coasters

Week 4 – Acrylic Paint onto pre poured canvas and jewellery making
